





Spring 2 Term 2023-2024

<u>English</u>

As writers we will be learning how to write a report. We will write our reports about fictional animals that we create. We will be focusing on writing in full sentences using capital letters, full stops, and question marks as well as using a variety of conjunctions to link and extend ideas.

<u>Maths</u>

As mathematicians, we will develop our knowledge of place value, looking at numbers up to 50 and counting in tens. We will expand our mathematical knowledge learning about measurement including length, height, mass, and volume.

<u>Science</u>

Properties of Materials -In this unit children will build upon their knowledge of materials from Spring 1. They will explore and discuss the properties of a range of materials. Once familiar with properties of materials, they will compare different materials by their properties. Finally, the children will use this foundation of knowledge to justify choices of material for well-known objects.

<u>PSHE</u>

Healthy Me

We will learn about Healthy lifestyles including healthy choices, being clean, medicine and road safety.

Computing

As Computing Technologists, we will be learning about early programming concepts through the use of Beebot robots.



Geography

As geographers we will be deciding whether we would rather live in Northampton or Hunstanton! We will be using photographs, atlases and maps to explore and compare our locality and a coastal region.



Physical Education

Ball skills - In this unit pupils will explore and develop their fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling and dribbling with both hands and feet. They will look to perform these skills with increasing control and accuracy using coordination and balance. Pupils will have the opportunity to work independently, and collaboratively in pairs and small groups.

As design technologists, we will be making moving minibeasts.

Religious Education

In our Religious Education lessons, we will be learning about Judaism. Answering the question 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'
