<u>English</u>

As writers we will be writing a non-chronological report, using The Tree Giants as a model text. We will learn this text, innovate it, learn about the toolkit and structure and finally write our own non-chronological report.

Science

As scientists we will be considering what things are alive and what are not alive. Are some things never alive? The children will also explore habitats around the world and consider why different creatures live in different places.

<u>Maths</u>

As mathematicians, we will be continuing to learn about multiplication and division, as well as length and height. The children will also explore mass, capacity, and temperature.

<u>PSHE</u>

Healthy Me

We will learn about the things that we need to do to stay healthy. We will learn about Healthy lifestyles including: healthy eating, being relaxed and using medicine safety.

<u>Music</u>

As musicians we will be working with a special teacher from Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts trust to learn about the ukelele.



Geography

As geographers we will be learning map skills. We will study aerial photos and maps of our school, Northampton and Inner London. We will be learning about human and physical features, using a key and understanding how maps help us.



Physical Education

In our PE lessons, we will be developing our ball skills by playing games and activities using walls and nets.

DT

We will be exploring products using axels and wheels. The children will think about how to plan and make a new product.

Religious Education

In our Religious Education lessons, we will learn about the Christian celebration of Easter.
