<u>Day 1</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics • Research tangrams • Challenge: design your own tangram 	<p>What objects would you put in a shoe box to represent you? Draw a shoe box with these objects. Then say why each object is special to you. Now write a letter of introduction to your new teacher/s, telling them as much as they can about yourself. Include family, hobbies, interesting characteristics, dislikes, favourites, etc. This could take the form of a formal letter, album, social media profile etc..</p>	<p>Read the book Silly Billy by Anthony Browne or watch the you tube video of it here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=j6RDfQa_Mo4 Explore the themes and encourage the children to share what worries them. <u>Day 2</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics • Pupils to create the net for a 3D shape and assemble the shape. 	<p>Pupils create a survival guide for Year 6 for pupils in Year 5. They include top tips, timetable, tests, how to prepare for SATs etc. They could choose a person in Year 5 to create the guide for.</p>	Session 6: Bouncebackability	PE
<u>Day 3</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematics • Tessalations: Using powerpoint, demo how to create tessalations. 	<p>Pupils to write letters to their friends they haven't seen during lockdown, telling them what they have been up to.</p>	Session 7: what is normal anyway?	Pupils use 'Garage Band ' on I pads to compose their own music, which they share with the class.

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<u>Day 4</u>	Mathletics	Use 'Hybrids' powerpoint to introduce hybrid animals. Pupils to create their own hybrid animal. They draw a picture and write a fact file/ report about it. Use 'Arctic Animals' report as an example. Pupils can create their report in booklet form, with cover, pictures etc.	Circle time activity from booklet.
<u>Day 5</u>	Mathletics	Introduce pupils to the flanimals: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Hzko1Pcb8VA Pupils to draw their own flanimal/s and write a fact file to accompany the picture/s.	Children to collect 4 suitable sized sticks in to use for session., or use looly pop sticks. Adult may need to assembly corners of frame prior to activity for some of the children. Children to wrap wool around to create a weaving frame and then go outside and collect leaves and flowers to add to their creations.
