In our Reading lessons we will develop our reading strategies whilst looking at the book 'Holes'. In Writing, we will look at characters, specifically looking at how characters are presented and what their relationships with other characters are like.

Maths:

Computing


As Computing Technologists, we will be continuing to explore and understand Microsoft office:

As geographers, we will be learning about where we live:


- Regions and counties in the UK
